Position Title: Preschool Reader

Immediate Supervisor: Teacher

Job Description

Read to preschool-age children for at least one-hour per week an Urban League Head Start Center. Currently, all 4 sites are available. All sites need readers during the day into the afternoon and early evening. The Head Start Center Coordinator will provide training and orientation. Available sites include:

- Martin Luther King Jr. Head Start Center – 1437 Laurel
- Mt. Zion Head Start Center – 1440 S. Compton
- 911 Head Start Center – 911 N. Spring
- Urban League Head Start Center – 8960 Jennings Station Road

Time Commitment

Requires a minimum of a 1-hour commitment per week. Must be dependable, as the children count on the readers showing up each week. Volunteers who make a regular commitment of 1 hour or more per week must be able to demonstrate that they are in good health, submit a tuberculosis screening with results, and a police background check.

This opportunity is available to adolescents, adults, and small groups (2 – 10).
